Round 1: Quarter-Final Games (4)

- Bowl Games or Home Games the 3rd Saturday of December.
- #1 team vs #8, etc. (Reassign any opponents from the same Conference or that met in the Regular Season.)

Round 2: Semi-Final Bowl Games (2)

- Bowl Games the 5th Saturday of December or January 1st.
- Rose, Sugar or Orange Bowls when their Contracted Conferences are in the Semi-Finals.
- Non-Contracted Teams in the Fiesta or Cotton Bowls.

Round 3: National Championship Game

- Bowl Game with the Winning Bid the next Saturday after January 4th.
